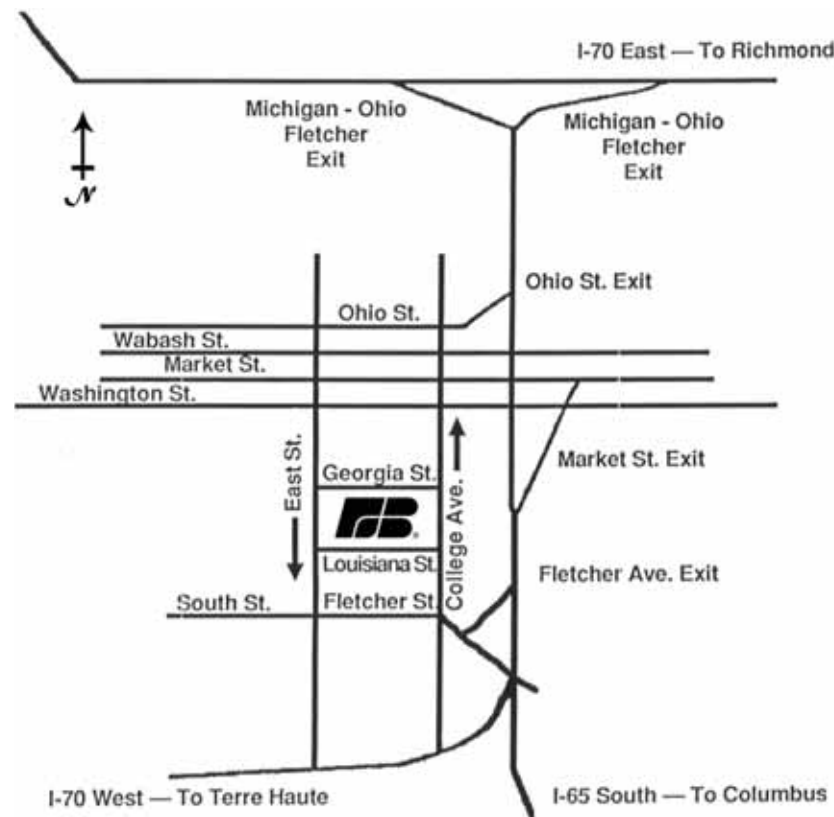
From I-65 southbound or I-70 westbound

The curriculum includes sessions on the basic legal framework of planning, comprehensive planning, zoning, subdivision control and defensible decision-making. Participants also will have extensive opportunities throughout the day to pose real local issues for discussion.

She regularly provides training to citizen planners around the state and is currently the chair of the Citizen Training Committee of the Indiana Planning Association.
